Dear Mr. Governor:

I am deeply sorry that you were forced to resign. Your resignation is regrettable for two reasons: 1. You have become yet another victim of LGBTI gender ideology and radical feminism in the United States, 2. Your removal is part of a plot to produce a soft coup in the United States in order to remove the current president of the United States and put the country in the hands of the radical socialist wing of the Democratic Party.

1. Today we are faced with the sad situation that women have the power to decide the expulsion of any man from his political position for which he was democratically elected by the people. In this way, women have been given the enormous power to override at any time the democratic choice made by the people with respect to any political office. And all this based on any accusation of sexual harassment that any woman or group of women decides to make. But not only have women been given that enormous power to invalidate elections in the field of politics, but they have also been given that enormous power in the field of the market to work within private companies. Today women have been allowed the enormous power to fire any man from his job and from top executive positions in private companies, based on the indictment of any woman who accuses him of sexual harassment.

That abuse of women against men must end. Legislation needs to be created so that no democratically elected male politician can be removed from office on charges of sexual harassment. Similarly, it is necessary to create legislation so that no man can be fired from his job based on accusations of sexual harassment.

Preventing women from being able to expel or displace men from the positions they occupy both in the field of politics, as in private business, must be a priority objective, both for Democrats and Republicans. To achieve that goal, Democrats must sit down to negotiate with Republicans the possible legislation that must be passed to prevent duly elected politicians from being removed from their positions based on any accusation of sexual harassment and the same with respect to being fired from work in the private company. To achieve this objective, it is necessary to organize politically the men within the Democratic and Republican parties to obtain the necessary electoral support.

Your dismissal as governor of New York is part of a plot to produce a soft coup in the United States with the aim of take out the President, Joe Biden and place instead the Socialists win of the Democratic Party. I invite you to be part of the Pro Justice Men Party of the United States and to become president of that party. Preventing that soft coup in the United States, as we already said, must be the first priority, not only of the Democrats in the United States, but also of the Republicans. If the country falls into the hands of the socialists, the current decline of the United States as the leading economic power relative to China, which I predicted a couple of years ago, will accelerate even more and the decline will be more dramatic.

What can be done? There are three courses of action to follow:

1. It is necessary to organize politically the men in the state of New York and in the other states of the country with the goal that you return to be the governor of New York.
2. It is necessary to organize politically men throughout the United States with the goal that you will become the next candidate for the presidency of the United States for the Democratic Party, after Biden leaves power.
3. We must denounce the existence of this plot to generate a soft coup in the United States with the idea of unmask them and thus dismantle it by preventing them from being able to brainwash people regarding the idea of removing the President by accusing him of being a sexual harasser.

I am not a Democrat, because of my conservative thinking I sympathize with the Republican party, but I understand that the United States is being subjected to a systematic and very well orchestrated attack to generate a soft coup and that avoiding it at all costs should be a priority objective.
